Fundraising Projects

Fundraising is a great way to earn credits for your student account. These credits can be used to pay the \$50.00 Fair Share, which is due Sept 6th (before uniform distribution), and used towards the Spring Musical Competition.

Joe Corbi is underway! Please have all orders and money ready on Aug 29th.

Bulk candy is also available by the box. Each box contains 30 candy bars and may be purchased for \$30.00. Students sell each bar for \$1.00. Your child's account will be credited \$10.00 for each box purchased.

Pre-packed bulk candy will also be available at candy sales and NEBOPO meetings.

How many Giant Cards do you need?

You can purchase Giant Store gift cards in denominations of \$25, \$50 or \$100. For every \$100 in gift cards you purchase, \$4 will go into your child's account and \$1 will be added to the general fund.

UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION!

Coming soon to a band room near you....

Uniform distribution is scheduled for 6:00-8:00 pm on August 28th, September 3rd, and September 4th. Sheets are available in the band room for students to sign up for a specific date & time for uniform fitting.

A date for majorettes and banner carriers to receive their uniforms will be advised.

At uniform distribution, band students and color guard will be fitted in their pants, jacket and hat. In order to save time, students are asked to wear gym shorts and a t-shirt for their fitting so they can try on the uniform over their clothes. Used shoes will be available for purchase or new shoes may be ordered (prices listed below). Students may also exchange shoes that no longer fit for no charge. Gloves may also be purchased.

Fees for any uniform accessories as well as a **\$10** cleaning fee must be paid before a uniform will be issued. Payment must be in the form of a check or money order payable to *NEBOPO*. **No cash** will be accepted. If you do not have payment when you come for your fitting, your uniform will be held until payment is received.
